Delivery:

-Sod can usually be delivered two days after the order is placed.

-Normally sod can be delivered on Saturdays, as long as the order is in by Thursday of that week. -We will call you the day before your delivery with an expected delivery time (usually a 2 hour window).

- Sod delivered straight to your home: \$150
- Sod delivered to the nursery (must be picked up same day): \$55
 - We may be able to help load directly into your vehicle with our tractor. This is subject to us having a tractor available, and a man to operate it. If your vehicle is too narrow to have the pallet loaded directly onto it, the sod will need to be loaded by hand. We may ask you to sign a waiver releasing us of any damage to your vehicle during loading and/or transportation of the sod.

Installation:

- Under 2,000 square feet:
 - o \$520 flat rate

- Over 2,000 square feet: flat rate plus
 - \$0.42 per square foot
 - \$0.47 per square foot for native varieties & special blends

Before sod is delivered and installed at your home, you will need to prep the area. The ground should be graded and leveled. Next, add 1-inch of compost and rototill it in. Rake it to finish the grade. Finally, roll the entire area to compact.

IN HOT WEATHER: The first week, new sod should be watered 4-6 times per day for 5-6 minutes. The second week, water 2-3 times per day for about 10 minutes. After two weeks, water sod once per day. *daily water should be 20-40 mins per day,

depending on type of sprinkler heads
