Creeping Thyme Thymus 'Elfin' or 'Reiter' CROUGHT OBCOUGHT OBCOUGHT Stablished	1-3 inches tall 12-18 inches spread	Evergreen Hardy to minus 10 degrees	Very low growing groundcover with tiny, fragrant green leaves. Small purple flowers in summer. Handles light foot traffic.	
Creeping Phlox Phlox subulate	2-3 inches tall 3-4 feet spread	Evergreen Hardy to minus 25 degrees	Showy spring flowers, usually around March and/or April Flowers purple, pink, or pink-red.	
Spreading Germander Teucrium majoricum	3-4 inches tall 3-4 feet spread	Evergreen Hardy to 15 degrees	Long-blooming, early summer until a frost Purple-pink blooms.	

Periwinkle Vinca minor	3-6 inches tall Continuously spreading	Evergreen Hardy to minus 20 degrees	Trailing stems of smooth, green leaves. Blue- purple flowers in spring. Spreads continuously wherever there is water – can be difficult to stop spread.	
Creeping Jenny Lysimachia nummularia	4-8 inches tall Continually spreading *'Goldilocks' variety has bright chartreuse- yellow leaves but does best with some shade	Semi-evergreen Hardy to minus 15 degrees (but goes deciduous in extreme cold)	Vigorous grower that re-roots itself and spreads to fill in an area. Low mat of rounded bright green leaves. Golden yellow flowers in late spring. Foliage may burn in extreme heat and turn reddish in cold.	
Green Mound Juniper Juniperus 'Green Mound' <b>DROUGHT</b> Once established	6-12 inches tall 4-6 feet spread *there are also similar low- growing junipers that have <b>blue</b> <b>foliage</b> like Juniper wiltonii and Juniper 'Blue Rug'	Evergreen Hardy to minus 20 degrees	Dense, spreading, rug-like shrub. Attractive blueish- green needles take on purplish hue in fall. Blue berries from late spring to late winter.	
Lowfast Bearberry Cotoneaster dammeri 'Lowfast'	10-12 inches tall 10-12 feet spread	Evergreen Hardy to minus 10 degrees	Trailing stems of glossy, dark green leaves. White flowers in spring followed by bright red berries.	

St. Johns Wort Hypericum calycinum	12-15 inches tall Continuously spreading	Evergreen Hardy to minus 5 degrees	Elongated green to blue-green leaves. Attractive yellow flowers in summer. Spreads continuously wherever there is water – can be difficult to stop spread.	
Creeping Rosemary Rosmarinus officinalis 'Prostratus'	1-2 feet tall 5-6 feet spread	Evergreen Hardy to 15 degrees	Aromatic green needle-like foliage. Lavender- blue flowers in winter and early spring.	
<b>Star Jasmine</b> Trachelosper mum jasminoides	1-2 feet tall 10-15 feet spread	Evergreen Hardy to 15 degrees	Commonly grown as a vine, but makes a great groundcover. Trailing, dark green leaves and fragrant, white flowers in summer. Take sun or some shade. May burn in cold winter.	



 $\rightarrow$  this symbol indicates plants that can survive drought once established. It takes 1-2 years of regular watering for a plant to be fully established. In general, plants will look better with regular water, but drought-tolerant plants can survive times when water is not available.

California Lilac Ceanothus	Size varies by type: 3 inches to 3 feet tall, 6-10 feet wide.	Evergreen Hardy to 15 degrees	Low, spreading shrub with oval, dark green leaves. Showy lilac flower spikes in spring. Flowers are loved by bees. Drought- tolerant once established.	
'Point Saint George' California Aster Aster 'Point Saint George'	4-6 inches tall 4-6 feet wide	Evergreen Hardy to 10 degrees	Low growing perennial with shiny green leaves. Beautiful daisy-like lavender flowers with yellow center. Blooms summer and fall. Drought- tolerant once established.	
'Emerald Carpet' Manzanita Arctostaphylos 'Emerald Carpet'	10-16 inches tall 4-6 feet wide	Evergreen Hardy to 5 degrees	Low, spreading shrub with glossy green leaves. Small pink bell flowers in early spring. Drought-tolerant once established.	

Spreading Sage Salvia 'Bee's Bliss' or 'Dara's Choice'	1-2 feet tall 4-6 feet wide	Evergreen Hardy to 15 degrees	Low-growing perennial with green or grey-green leaves. Soft lavender-blue flower clusters in summer. Leaves and flowers are very aromatic. Drought- tolerant once established.	
Dwarf Coyote Bush Baccharis 'Pigeon Point' or 'Twin Peaks'	1-2 feet tall 6-8 feet wide	Evergreen Hardy to 15 degrees	Spreading shrub with tiny, light green leaves. Insignificant cream flowers in spring. Drought-tolerant once established.	
Hancock Snowberry Symphoricarpos x chenaultii 'Hancock'	2-3 feet tall 5-8 feet wide	Deciduous Hardy to minus 15 degrees	Native hybrid with blue-green leaves and small coral berries in fall. Spreads quickly to cover ground and smother weeds. May need yearly trimming to keep low (can grow tall on its own).
