'Summer Sunshine' Germander Teucrium chamaedrys 'Summer Sunshine'	6-12 inches tall 12-18 inches wide	Evergreen Hardy to minus 20 degrees	Small, glossy golden-green leaves with serrated edges. Purple-rose flower spikes in summer makes nice contrast against foliage. Deer rating: 8/10
