Lavender japonicas 'Nigra' flower spikes in summer followed by purple berries in fall. Deer rating: 10/10

Royal Purple Lily Turf Liriope muscari 'Royal Purple'	12-18 inches tall 12-18 inches wide	Evergreen Hardy to 0 degrees	Grass-like green blades year-round. Spikes of deep purple flowers rise above foliage in summer. <i>Also</i> <i>available</i> <i>variegated with</i> <i>green and white</i> <i>blades – Liriope</i> <i>'Silvery Sunproof'</i> Deer rating: 9/10	
Gold Band Sedge Carex 'Gold Band' DROUGHT Once established	12-18 inches tall 1-2 feet wide	Evergreen Hardy to 0 degrees	Narrow, deep green blades variegated with golden margins which fade to white. Brownish flower spikes in summer are short-lived and inconspicuous. Deer rating: 10/10	
Japanese Forest Grass Hakonechloa macra 'Aureola'	1-2 feet tall 1-2 feet wide	Deciduous, melts to ground for winter Hardy to 0 degrees	Attractive, graceful grass with bright yellow foliage. Tall and arching habit. Also available with variegated green/yellow blades – Hakenochloa 'Aureola' <b>Deer rating: 10/10</b>	
Everillo Sedge Carex 'Everillo'	1-2 feet tall 1-2 feet wide *there are varieties of this grass that grow taller or bloom white	Evergreen Hardy to 0 degrees	Lime green foliage matures to bright, golden yellow. In sunnier spots, yellow intensifies. In extreme shade, foliage is more chartreuse. Nice pop of color in shade garden. Deer rating: 10/10	



 $\rightarrow$  this symbol indicates plants that can survive drought once established. It takes 1-2 years of regular watering for a plant to be fully established. In general, plants will look better with regular water, but drought-tolerant plants can survive times when water is not available.

Creeping Red Fescue Festuca rubra 'Molate'	12-18 inches tall 12-18 inches wide	Evergreen Hardy to 0 degrees or below	Soft, flowing drifts of blue-grey-green foliage. Buff colored flower spikes rise 2-3 feet high in summer. Can be mowed to 2 inches tall. Deer rating: 10/10	
California Gray Rush Juncus patens	1-2 feet tall 1-2 feet wide	Evergreen Hardy to 15 degrees	Thin, rounded, grey- green leafless stems. Inconspicuous golden- brown flower clusters below the leaf tips from spring to fall. Very tough – can grow in very dry or very wet area. <b>Deer rating: 9/10</b>	
Purple Needlegrass Stipa pulchra	1-3 feet tall 1-2 feet wide	Deciduous Hardy to 5 degrees	Bunch grass with blades that are bright green up close, appear grey from a distance. Airy cream flowers with hints of purple in late summer. Drought-tolerant once established. <b>Deer rating: 10/10</b>	
Deer Grass Muhlenbergia rigens	2-3 feet tall 2-3 feet wide	Semi-evergreen Hardy to 5 degrees	Dense clump of slender arching green blades. Tan flower spikes above foliage in fall. Plumes can reach 5 feet tall. Drought-tolerant once established. <b>Deer rating: 10/10</b>
