Flowers may be lavender, purple, shades of pink, or white. Plant dies back for winter then comes back larger the next year. May flower less with heavy shade.	
Star Jasmine Trachelosper mum jasminoides *for part sun or part shade areas	Grows 15-20 feet *Yellow Star Jasmine blooms light yellow and handles colder temperatures (to around 5 degrees)	Evergreen Hardy to 20 degrees	Trailing, dark green leaves and fragrant, white flowers in summer. Takes sun or some shade.	O Robert Perry

Variegated Ivy Hedera helix 'Variegata' *for part sun or part shade areas	Grows 20-30+ feet	Evergreen Hardy to 20 degrees	Medium-sized, five-pointed leaves are variegated. Leaves are green with creamy white or yellow edges. Aggressive grower, can be difficult to stop.	
Climbing Hydrangea Hydrangea petoliaris *for part shade to full shade areas	Grows 30-50+ feet	Deciduous Hardy to minus 20 degrees	Slow-growing, shrubby habit until established, then becomes vigorous. Lush, green foliage. Attaches to surfaces by aerial rootlets. Magnificent, white, lacecap blooms in summer Aggressive grower, may require several prunings per year to contain.	



 \rightarrow this symbol indicates plants that can survive drought once established. It takes 1-2 years of regular watering for a plant to be fully established. In general, plants will look better with regular water, but drought-tolerant plants can survive times when water is not available.

Flowers are yellowish at base with pink 'fingers'. Flowers are loved by hummingbirds. Red berries are edible but bitter, and loved by birds.	
California Wild Grape Vitis californica *for part sun or part shade areas	Grows 20- 30 feet	Deciduous Hardy to minus 20 degrees	Large green leaves and twisted, woody vines. Leaves turn shades of orange, yellow, & red in fall. Clusters of small purple fruits are edible but often sour.
